The Healthy Homes Project helps improve the health of families with asthmatic kids by providing **FREE** in-home services:

Housing Assessment

At the first home visit, your Healthy Homes Community Specialist will conduct a housing assessment. The assessment will include, but is not limited to, the following:

- presence of water leaks/damage, allergens, safety hazards, lead hazards, and pests
- condition of carpet/floor covering
- condition of ventilation system

Health Education

Your Healthy Homes Community Specialist will provide your family with information on the following:

- asthma triggers and prevention
- maintaining a healthy home
- lead hazard prevention
- home safety concerns
- integrated pest management

Asthma Trigger Reduction Services

The Project will determine what if any home repairs are necessary to reduce asthma triggers for the child. **FREE** Repairs may include allergen treatments, exhaust fan repairs, carpet removal, and minor lead-based paint repair work.

Referrals are made to other community services, as needed.

On-Going Support

Families are asked to participate in the Project for six months.

Our homes can make us feel safe, provide privacy, and can support our good health <u>or</u> can trigger asthma & allergies, cause injuries & create stress.

The Healthy Homes Project provides FREE in-home services to help you keep your home as healthy as it can be for your family.
